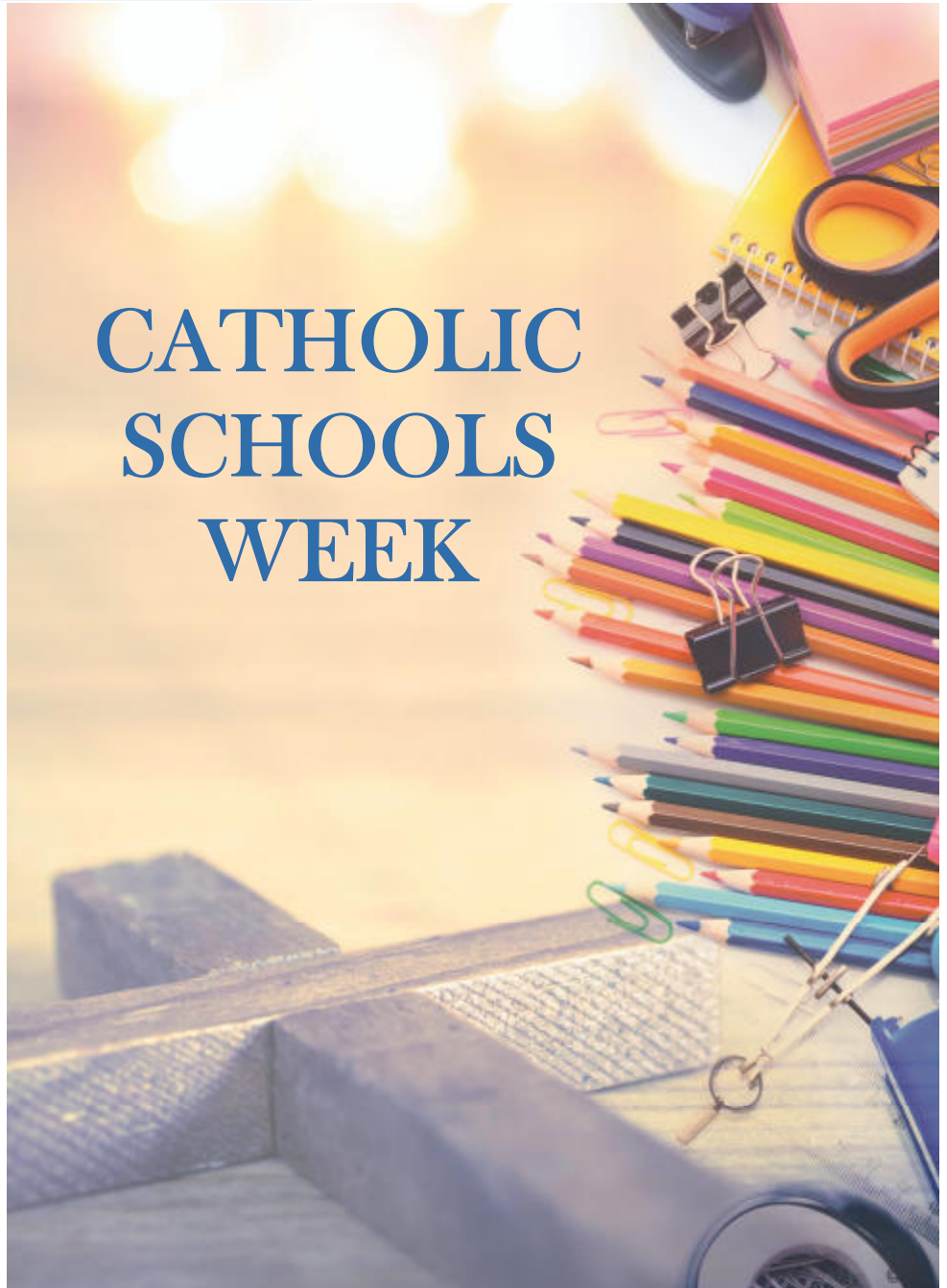

Dear Parishioners:

This week is National Catholic School's Week. Here are 10 Reasons why there are Catholic Schools:
