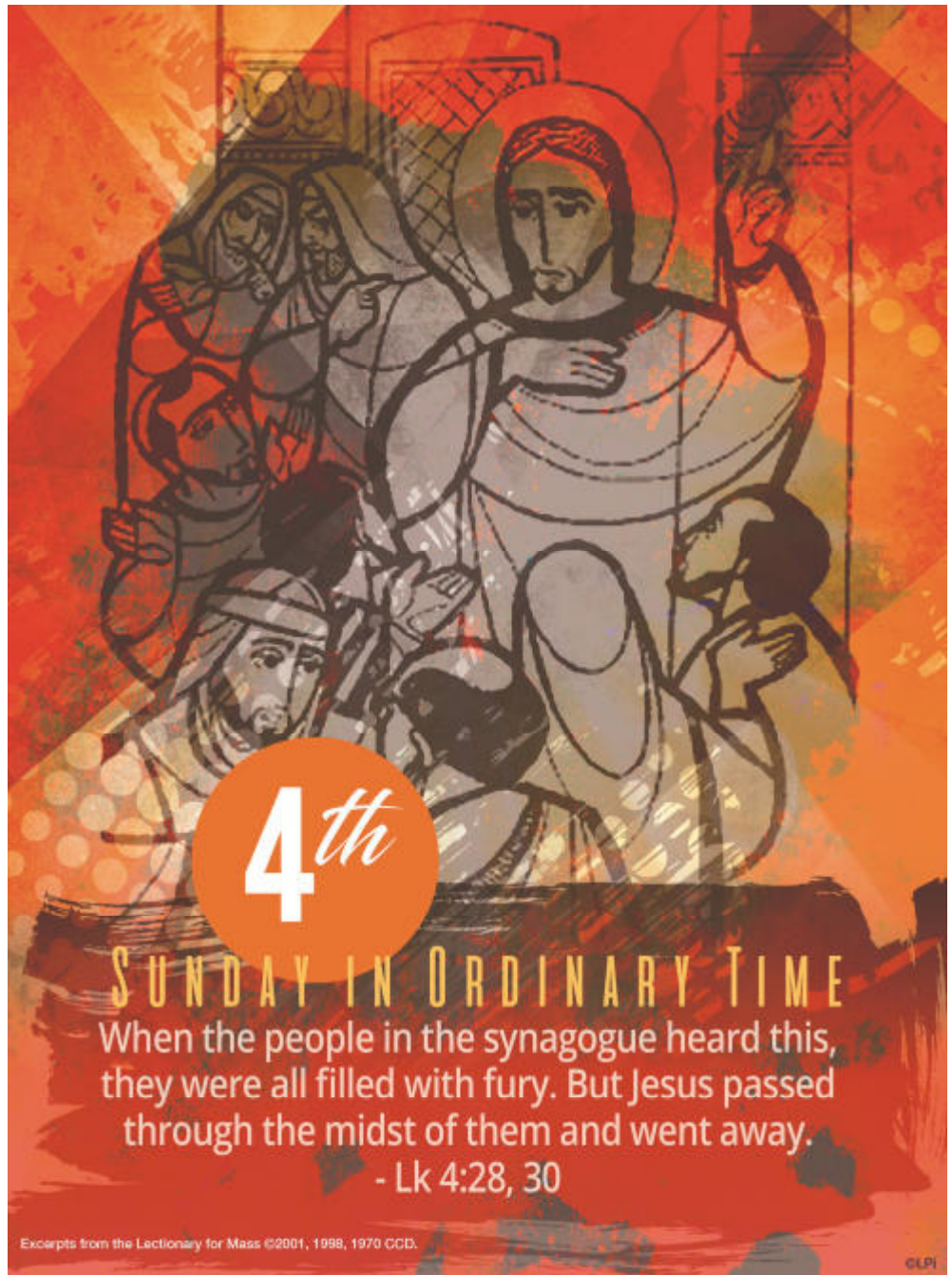

Thoughts From Fr. Richard Fox ...

My Dear People:

Traditionally, our parish has blessed throats on the Sunday nearest to the feast day of St. Blaise, Bishop and Martyr. This year, the 4th Sunday of Ordinary Time actually lands upon the memorial. As a result, I believe and anticipate that there will be even more graces poured out as we bless throats!

St. Blaise devoted the early years of his life to the study of philosophy and later became a physician. He was later ordained to the priesthood and was soon made Bishop of Sebaste in Armenia. While there, he was captured and imprisoned for this faith and religious practice by Governor Agricolous.

On his way to prison, he encountered a distraught mother whose child was suffering from either a disease of the throat or a fish bone caught in his throat. She implored the bishop to pray for the child. At the holy bishop's prayer of intercession, the child was cured!

While imprisoned, the saint was cruelly tortured and eventually beheaded in the year 316. However, the story

continues with the grateful woman visiting the bishop while he was in prison and giving him the gift of candles to light his darkened cell. Jesus is the light of the world and it is he who scatters the darkness of original and personal sin, as well as all illness, disease and even death itself.

These are the events which led to St. Blaise being solicited for any and all diseases and maladies of the throat and our using candles in the form of a cross to administer the blessing over the People of God. Over the centuries, many have been either cured of throat diseases or protected from them.

Here is the prayer said by either a priest or a deacon as the crossed candles are placed or held over the people: "Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every disease of the throat and from every other illness: In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." Like the woman and child, let us approach the Lord with expectant faith and receive!

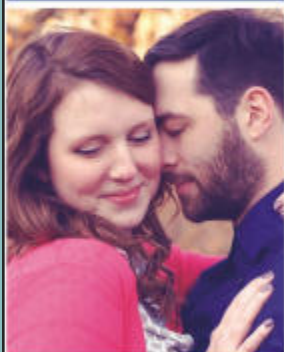
