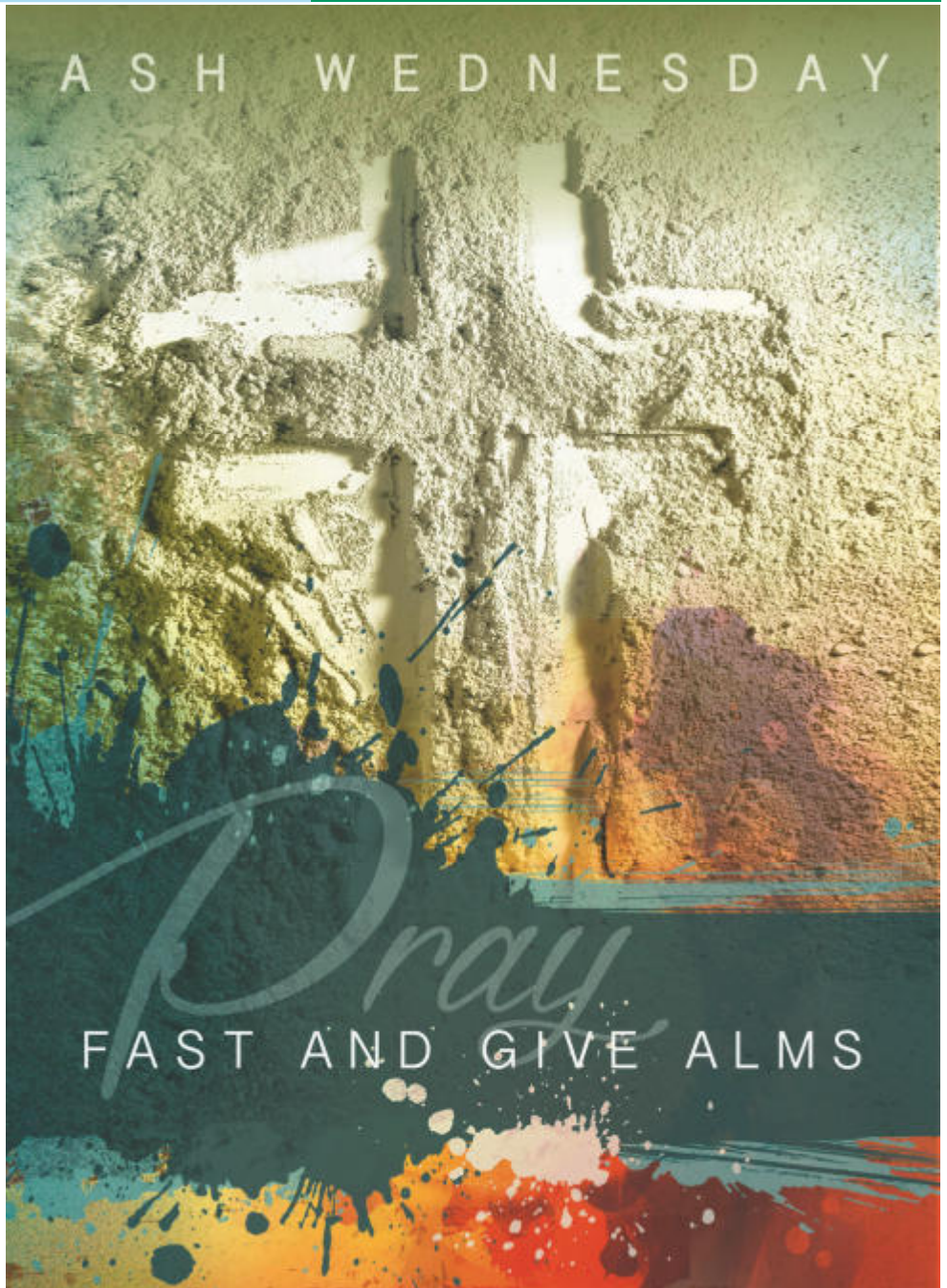

A WORD FROM DEACON JIM BOORMAN ...

In our reading from Sirach we hear, "Praise no one before he speaks, for it is then that he is tested." I hope that over the past 9 years that I have truly done my best to convey the Will of the Father in all of my homilies and teachings. I hope that the words I have shared with you have taken root in your lives and to even cause you to change the course of your life. The way you pray and worship, the way you respond to God and the way that you treat others and steer the course of your society. Someday I'll get my report card, "... when this which is corruptible clothes itself in incorruptibility and this which is mortal clothes itself in immortality" ... I truly hope that I will be able to say, "Death where is your sting?" as I am sure each and every one of you also wish ... but how desperately do you wish it?

We all get comfortable in our skins, in our world, our families, our way of doing and thinking things and living in our society; and in that comfort we tend to turn a blind eye to the bad that happens around us, especially if it threatens to cause us turmoil ... we ARE human after all and we do not like pain or change ... we resist it ... mightily. But the truth of the matter is that we cannot get to heaven from where most of us are currently. We MUST move, we MUST change and since we ARE the Body of Christ in this world, we MUST CHANGE as the Body of Christ ... as our Community ... and as our Society. That is our task ... that is our responsibility as Christians, more so as Catholics, and as disciples and you must choose to live up to that ... or run away and hide. We can face God with a good conscience that we have done what we could in this world and in this society, or we can hide our heads in the sand ... for all the good that will do for us and for the Body of Christ ... don't be an Ostrich. Open your hearts and minds this coming Lent ... Do Something to Change the way that God sees You.
