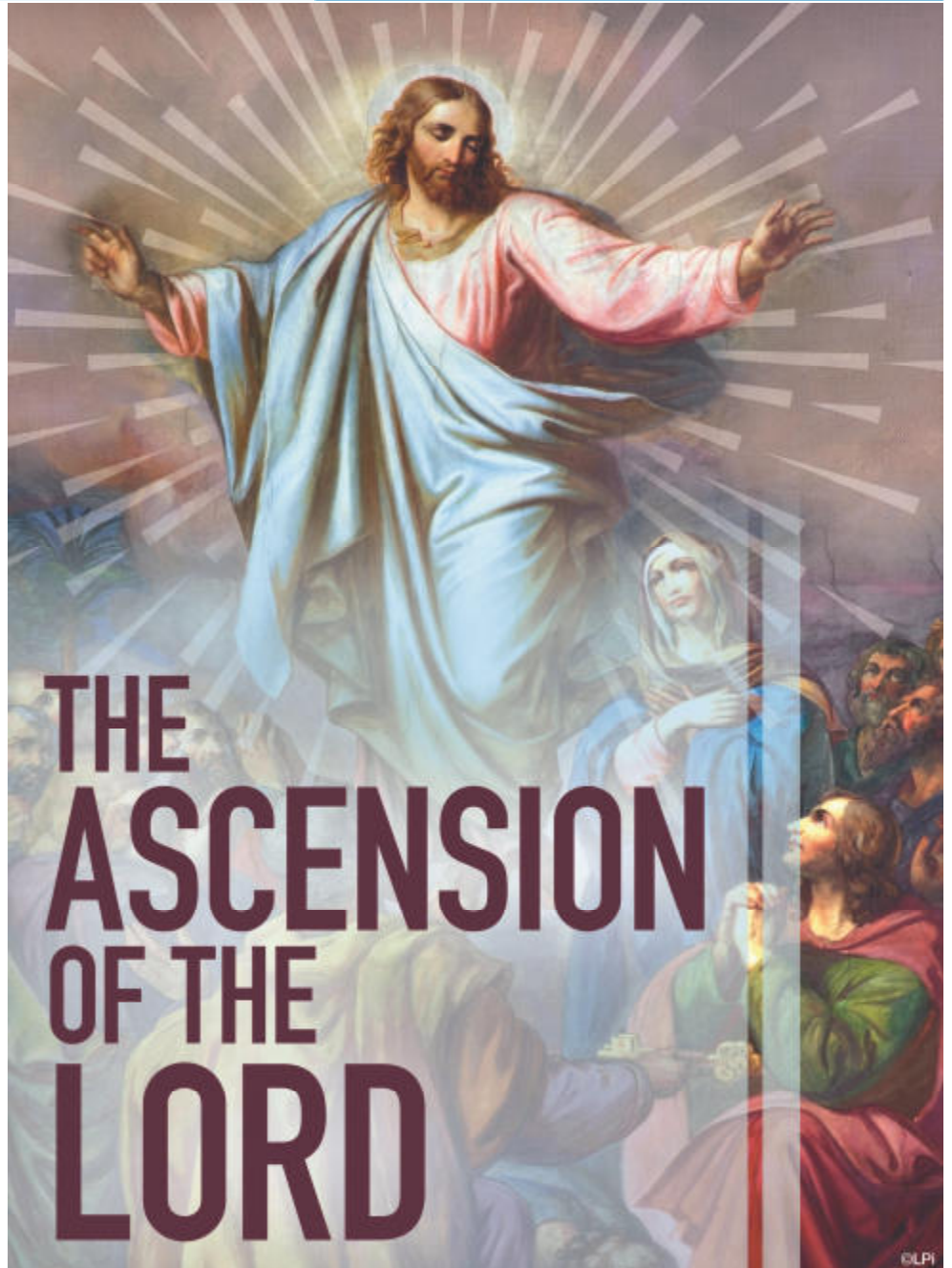

***THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD
SEVENTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
June 1-2, 2019***

Jesus states; "I do not pray for the world..." John often uses "the world" to mean human beings and that insofar as it is fallen, in rebellion against God, and under the power of sin (or the evil one). Jesus does not pray for "the world" insofar as it is "the world" as it rejects the Father and the Son. Jesus is going to send his disciples into the hostile, unbelieving, world as an extension of his own mission. Through the visible unity, faithfulness, and love, they bear witness to the reality of the Father's love in Jesus, so that the world may come to believe and be redeemed. Creation ceases to be "the world" as it receives Jesus and enters into redemption. C.K. Barrett puts it well: "To pray for the [world] would be almost an absurdity, since the only hope for "the world" is precisely that it should cease to be the [world]"

Although Jesus will no longer be in the world, His disciples will still be in the world, and they are going to face its hatred in the form of persecutions, hostility, and temptation. While the world hates the disciples because of their relationship to Jesus, the Father loves

them for the same reason.

Remember "the world" belongs to the Prince of this world who is the evil one, by any name you wish to call him, and because it belongs to him it is already lost to the point that Jesus, distinctly, does not even pray for it ... and those in it.

Jesus goes on to say "No one can take them out of my hand ... and no one can take them out of the Father's hand." But that; "they may be as one just as we are one." What does this mean? It means that we MUST remove ourselves from "the world" and make ourselves His. We must DESIRE this and move ourselves toward it ... we cannot just SIT in this world ... or we are lost with it. Those that truly wish it will find themselves in God's hands ... but this requires desire and action on our parts to do so ... take up your discipleship.

Supreme Court Sanity: In 2007, the US Supreme Court upheld the federal ban on "partial-birth abortion," a procedure in which a child is deliberately killed in the birth process. In that decision, *Gonzales v. Carhart*, the majority opinion states, "Respect for human life finds an ultimate expression in the bond of love the mother has for her child... It is self-evident that a mother who comes to regret her choice to abort must struggle with grief more anguished and sorrow more profound when she learns, only after the event, what she once did not know: that she allowed a doctor to pierce the skull and vacuum the fast-developing brain of her unborn child, a child assuming the human form."
