Dear Parishioners:

This year's Lenten season arrives somewhat later than last year's. This is because Church law requires that Easter be scheduled on the first Sunday following the first full moon after the vernal equinox (Beginning of Spring). Last year, Easter was April 1. In 2019, Easter comes on April 21.

Why does the Church do this? According to the bible, Jesus Christ's death and resurrection occurred around the time of the Jewish Passover, which was celebrated on the first full moon following the vernal equinox. The date for Easter varied a bit during the early days of the Church: At the end of the 2nd Century, some celebrated Easter on the actual day of the Jewish Passover, while others celebrated it on the following Sunday.

Finally, in 325 A.D., the Council of Nicaea established that Easter would be held on the first Sunday after the first full moon occurring on or after the vernal equinox. From that date forward, the Easter date depended on the ecclesiastical approximation of March 21 for the vernal equinox. If the full moon is on a Sunday, Easter is then delayed by one week.

The season of Lent occurs 40 days before Easter. It strives to replicate Jesus Christ's prayer, fasting and sacrifice as he withdrew into the desert. Following this, the Lord then began his public ministry. This

makes Lent begin on Ash Wednesday (March 6, 2019) and end on the evening of Holy Saturday (March 20, 2019). However, in the Catholic tradition, the "General Norms for the Liturgical Year and Calendar" was updated in 1969 and it says that "Lent runs from Ash Wednesday until the Mass of the Lord's Supper (Holy Thursday evening) (March 18, 2019)(The beginning of the 3 day Sacred Triduum) exclusive." So, if one strictly follows this directive, then Lent actually ends on March 18. In the same spirit, the Church directives are that Sundays of Lent are not penitential in nature and are not actually part of Lent. Thus, Lenten resolutions do not need to be followed on Sundays. That said, there is also nothing "wrong" with choosing to stick to your Lenten resolutions on every single day from Ash Wednesday all the way to the Easter Vigil! Enjoy Lent! It helps us to remember what matters most. Anticipate Easter! It actually is what matters most!
